Info/Route Sheet:

Whilst this walk isn't a tour, some of you may be interested in the places we'll pass. I've put together a couple of pages you can read beforehand or print off to bring along.

The Route

After we start in the Market place we will follow this rough route

Down Stodman Street towards Castle Gate
Left onto Castle Gate
Down The Lock Passage to the River
Along the river to the Castle
up Cuckstool wharf and back onto Castle Gate

Up Coach and Horses Passage (keep an eye out for the Urine Deflector)


Middlegate to boar lane Castle Gate to Kirk Gate

up Kirkgate to Wilson Street

through the church gardens and then friary Gardens Up Magnus Street and back down Appleton Gate

Down Barnby Gate hen Bede House Lane, looping back through Sherwood Avenue Park donw guildhall stee and back up Baldertongate

Carter Gate through to The Olde White Hart Quick wander through Ironmonger row (what was) Back to Meeting Point
